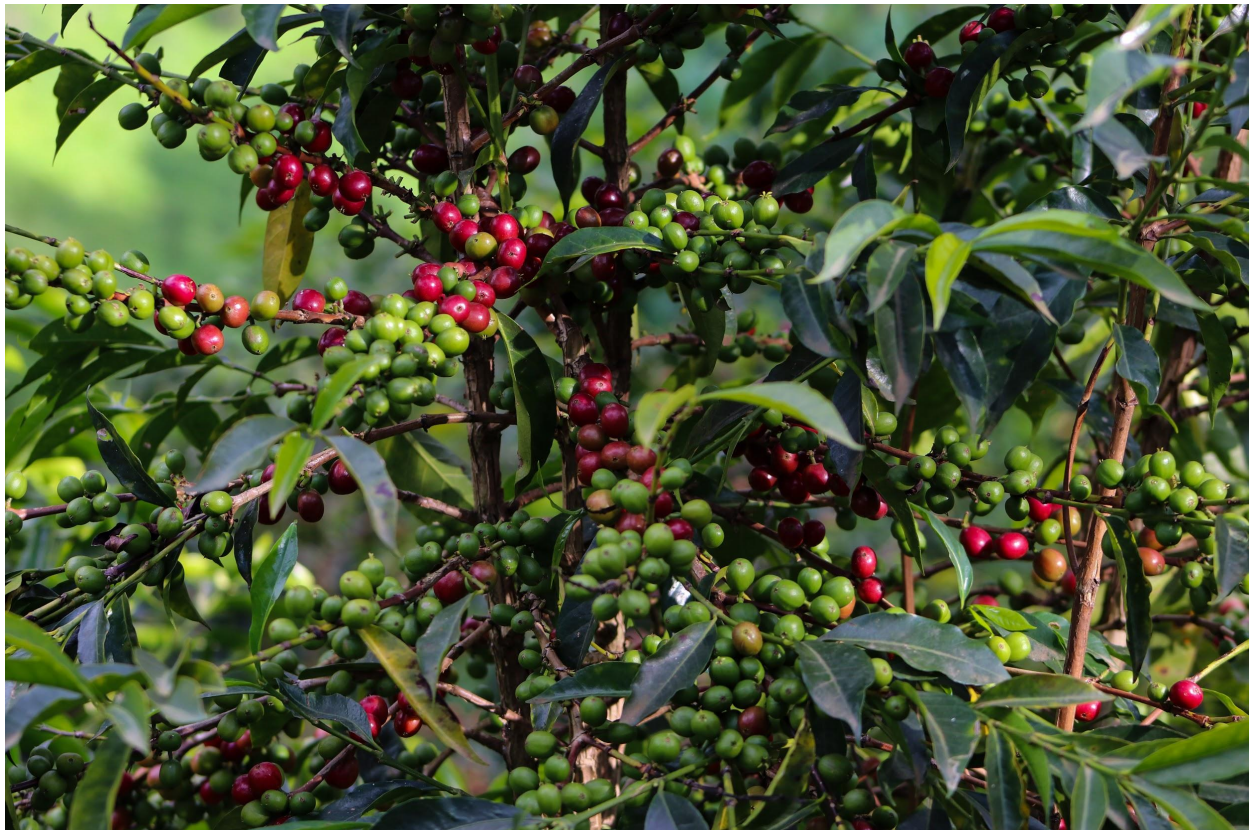


ELALA BONA QIQE

Bona (Bona Zuria) is one of 30 districts in Sidama. The altitude of Bona is around 2,200m above sea level and located at the highest altitude among other coffee-growing areas in the country. The coffee available in this area is categorized as Highland Coffee.
